## **Minutes**

### **I. Minutes**

They were uncomfortable with the reaction by non-tenured faculty were it to be placed so prominently among the factors considered for reappointment and tenure.
- The **FEC** expressed its willingness to discuss a possible inclusion of the FDC, as well as the movement of the language to another location. The most appropriate seemed to be in the neighborhood of criteria for promotion.
