
### Sexual and Gender-Based Misconduct Policies

- Skidmore College prohibits the crimes of:
  - Sexual Harassment
    - Quid Pro Quo
    - Severe, Pervasive, & Objectively Offensive
  - Sexual Assault
  - Dating Violence
  - Domestic Violence
  - Stalking
- Affirmative consent definition still applies.
- Retaliation remains prohibited.

- There are two policies for faculty that may be applied in response to sexual and gender-based misconduct (SGBM) depending on jurisdiction:
  - Title IX Policy
  - Anti-Harassment Policy for Faculty
